

Brenda St. John: Charismatic matriarch of the St. John Dairy outside of Macon. She was in charge of the business and PR end of the dairy while her husband, a veterinarian, took care of the farm and animals. Cheerful, but a little more raunchy than matronly. After her husband was killed during the zombie outbreak, she became fiercely protective of the dairy and her sons.

Now, in episode 2, with people starving, the dairy finds itself in a unique position: with enough fuel to run their generators, they can continue to produce milk and butter and with the hunting skills of the two St. John sons, they can fill their freezer with meat: all things that can be traded and bartered in this post-apocalyptic “economy.”

Nevertheless, the St. John sons are great hunters: except they are hunting people. By trading human meat they have kept their farm in tip-top-shape and now needs the player’s group to ally with them (as they have a vet in the group).

Brenda St. John is the mastermind behind the dairy’s plot and, as the episode unfolds, becomes truly villainous.

About The Walking Dead: The Walking Dead is a serialized, episodic video game based on an acclaimed comic series. There is also a television show based on the comic material. Our story is a new one in the world of The Walking Dead and is based on the typical zombie apocalypse milieu, save that the stories of The Walking Dead are more long-form. It is about people trying to survive with each other months and even years after the infection. The player plays as Lee Everett, a man struggling to take care of little girl he finds alone right after the world begins to fall. The tone of it is similar to something like *The Wire* or *Mad Men*, but with hordes of shambling undead.

Scene: Brenda sits mixing cookie dough on the porch of her house.

BRENDA: [cheerful] Well hey there... Lee, was it?

LEE: That's right, ma'am.

BRENDA: Well, come on up! What're you needin'?

LEE: I'm just checking on the food.

BRENDA: Oh, you poor things. I know y'all are just starving. Sometimes I forget how much we have. It'll be ready before too long.

Scene: A conversation with Lee

BRENDA: Sittin' out here, looking over the farm, I can pretend that things are like they used to be. Are you married, Lee?

LEE: Why?

BRENDA: [teasing] Now don't you get nervous. I like my men a lot huskier than you.

Scene: Her secret revealed, Brenda holds Katjaa as a human shield while Lee and the group descends on her house.

BRENDA: I don't wanna kill y'all!

LEE: Brenda, let her go.

BRENDA: You think I'm stupid? I let her go and you'll kill me! Just leave my family alone!

LEE: Your family's dead.

BRENDA: No! You're lying!

BRENDA: [almost crying] Danny's not evil. He just... he needs help!

LEE: How many people have you killed?

BRENDA: The world's different now! How many people have YOU killed?

BRENDA: [screaming in pain] Ahhhhhhh!
